Our year 9 10 and 11 students took part in the school's careers fair this month - thank you to all our local businesses who supported us as we could not do this without you! The students had the opportunity to talk about careers and apprenticeships with a fantastic array of successful local businesses - some of whom brought current apprentices with them to talk first hand about 'earning and learning' as an apprentice.



We have also had a number of competitive successes - some fantastic accomplishments by our students. The maths team took eight of our finest mathematicians to Keele University to take part in a 'Maths Feast' - a competition pitting a number of schools from the West Midlands area against each other. Mr McKinnon reported that 'the Mathematics was fiendish, with no calculators allowed! Each round was structured differently to shift focus from independent work to collaborative work and although neither team finished in the top three, St. Martins school was one of only three schools at the event to be recognised for our impressive level of team work, something that fits the ethos of our school perfectly. teacher pride was high and the Maths was 'very, very tasty.'

Closer to home Mr James took a number of students to compete in Oswestry Youth Music Festival where St Martins Band were awarded joint 2nd place in the ensemble category with a distinction mark with their performance of a 60's medley and George Winter won the 'new to learning an instrument' category with a distinction mark.







IFTON MEADOWS COLLIERY WALK ON SUNDAY 16 JUNE 2019.

I have arranged beginning at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday 16 June 2019 for a walk of between one and a half hours and up to two hours long to take place.

Parking is best in Colliery Road, near the entrance to Ridgway Rentals Ltd, Earthmovers etc., Colliery Road, Ifton Colliery Site – the Eastern side of the former colliery, Post Code SY11 3PZ. Please do not block the site entrance to the Company it is used 7 days a week. Those arriving on foot should come to the same place as this is where the walk will start and finish.

I have arranged this walk with the considerable help of Sue Schofield, plus Terry Ellis, Ken Hinton and Colin Williams, retired Ifton Colliery miners who worked at Ifton Colliery until 1968 when it closed, plus Ann Williams who was one of the driving forces behind the creation of Ifton Meadows. As you may know, the nature reserve was created on and from the former coal mine waste heap, the area landscaped, grassed over and saplings planted, becoming what it is today, an area for the local community to enjoy in their leisure time.

While the area is always open to the public to enjoy I thought with the help of the above, we could not only have a gentle ramble, but also benefit from hearing details about the site from the retired miners. Nothing remains of the mine and the shaft is capped over and a fence around it. It is located within an area now occupied by modern industrial units, so I do not want anyone to turn up and then be disappointed. However the lack of former buildings to see (a couple do remain) will I know be more than made up for by our guides who have kindly given up their time to show us around.

I have obtained a few copies of a free leaflet and map published in 2018 by Shropshire Council with input from the Ifton Meadows committee. I will bring a few copies along to share out but if you would like to obtain a copy in advance, they are available free of charge from Pentre Nursery, Glyn Morlas Road / Clarkes Lane Junction on the Western side of the former colliery, when the Nursery is open. Telephone: 01691 – 772475 to check first.

Good quality, strong footwear is required and while the gradients are modest there are some steep parts. You will be rewarded for your efforts not only to see what the area looks like 50 years after the mine closed but on a clear day excellent views toward Glyn Morlas, Chirk and the Welsh Hills.

If the weather is extremely wet it would be wise not to undertake the walk. If in doubt, telephone me about 2 hours before it is due to start on 0788 455 4154.

The walk could of course be undertaken by anyone at any time.



The walk is undertaken at your own risk, as we do not have insurance cover in the event of anyone injuring themselves.

It would be very useful to have an indication of the numbers attending. A text message would be best up to a couple of days before it begins. Locals, relatives, friends, children and dogs are all welcome. Most of the route is suitable for push chairs and prams.

There is no charge for this event and I can assure you the walk will be well worth it!


MARCH 2019 MEETING

St Martins Recreation Ground Update



After a long series of discussions between the Parish Council, St Martins School and the Brynkinalt Estate, agreement has been reached on the preferred boundaries for the new recreation ground to be created behind St Martins School. The drawing above shows, on the left hand side, the new land being provided to the community by the Brynkinalt Estate and compares it to the original proposal (on the top right hand side) for recreation land behind the approved housing development at Rhosyllan Farm. The drawing also indicates in outline how a new MUGA, a 3G football ground, car parking and a cricket pitch could be included on the site, and is part of the planning application which has been lodged by the Parish Council with Shropshire Council, seeking a change of use for the new land from agricultural to recreation and education use.

If, as expected, this application is successful (and that should be known by mid-May of this year) the serious business of designing the detailed layout of the new land, plus the current school playing field and other sports facilities at St Martins School, so that it can be developed and made available for use by both the School and the local community.

A launch event, to which all interested local clubs and individuals will be invited, is likely to be held at the school during the coming Summer term, so watch for details of what will mark the start of an exciting partnership between the School and the Community thanks in no small part to the generosity of the Estate providing the additional land (which will also provide space for future education expansion at the School).
